Dear Parent/Guardian:

**Re: Interdistrict Transfers for the 2006-2007 School Year**

The interdistrict transfer that allowed your student to attend school in the San Lorenzo Unified School District during the 2005-2006 school year will expire on June 30, 2006. The California Education Code provides for the renewal of interdistrict transfers on an annual basis.

During the past few years the San Lorenzo Unified School District's ability to approve interdistrict transfers has decreased considerably due to increased enrollment of students residing within the San Lorenzo Unified School District boundaries. Enrollment projections for the 2006-2007 school year indicate the continuation of this trend.

Therefore, it is likely that the San Lorenzo Unified School District *may not be able to approve* interdistrict transfers for continuing students *nor any* interdistrict transfer requests for new students.

San Lorenzo Unified School District will adhere to past practice in determining criteria for accepting new and renewal interdistrict transfer requests should space become available. These include:

- \* Evidence of regular attendance
- \* Evidence of good scholarship
- \* Evidence of good behavior

Should you wish to apply for an interdistrict transfer to the San Lorenzo Unified School District, *you must initiate the request in your district of residence*. You are advised to do this before June 15, 2006.

You are strongly encouraged to arrange for the enrollment of your student in your district of residence for the 2006-2007 school year in order to secure an educational placement for your student in the event that the San Lorenzo Unified School District is unable to approve your interdistrict transfer request. Waiting until the beginning of the 2006-2007 school year to do this might jeopardize your chance of securing enrollment in your neighborhood school.
