Dear Parent/Guardian:

The California Education Code requires that students attend school in the school district in which *their parents* reside.

The San Lorenzo Unified School District continues to experience a growth in enrollment in all schools. Due to the increased number of students enrolling, the district requires verification of residence from families of *all* students entering grade six and grade nine. These students include both students new to the district and those who have just completed the curriculum at a district elementary or middle school.

Acceptable proofs of residence may include the following:

1. Escrow papers showing the parents' name and property address.
2. Rental agreement and receipt for deposit showing name and telephone number of the rental unit manager and parents' name and property address.
3. Current utility bill (PGE, telephone or water), Cable TV invoice or service requested invoice (within thirty days of enrollment) showing parents' name and property address.
4. Current homeowner's or car insurance bill showing parents' name and property address.
5. Current bank statement showing name and address of parents or Social Service statement showing the name of the student and name and address of parents.
6. The parent's most recent pay voucher indicating the parent's address. The salary amount and all personal information (social security number, etc.) should be concealed.

Parents *who reside outside* of the San Lorenzo Unified School district wanting their students to attend San Lorenzo Unified School District schools have the right to apply for interdistrict permits from their school district of residence. These permits will be considered for approval based upon reason and space availability.
