

The Employment Process Substitute Teachers

The San Lorenzo Unified School District maintains a substitute teacher base so that our students continue to receive a high standard of education while their regular teacher is ill or gone on a staff development activity.

In order to be employed as a substitute teacher in the San Lorenzo Unified School District, the District requires that the candidate have a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university. Official transcripts will need to be obtained as proof that the degree was granted. The candidate must have taken and passed the California Basic Educational Skills Test (CBEST).

A 30-day substitute permit from the State of California will make the employee eligible to substitute for one year from date of issuance. The District will help the candidate file for this permit; however, the fees associated with this permit are the responsibility of the employee.
